






# The Six Core Service Domains

<b>Healthcare</b>  <p>Continuous access to primary/ emergency care, essential medicines, and non-discriminatory triage.</p>	<b>Clean Water &amp; Sanitation</b>  <p>Reliable potable water and hygiene services in public institutions (schools/clinics).</p>	<b>Education</b>  <p>Free equitable access to early childhood through lower-secondary; inclusive curricula.</p>
<b>Energy</b>  <p>Safe household energy for lighting/cooking; continuity standards to avoid harmful outages.</p>	<b>Adequate Housing</b>  <p>Legal protection against forced eviction; minimum habitability and safety standards.</p>	<b>Digital Connectivity</b>  <p>Affordable, safe internet access; protection of privacy; basic digital literacy.</p>





# Compliance Principles: Building Trust

# Risk Analysis and Mitigation Strategies

Risk	Mitigation
Policy Volatility	Use administrative circulars and interpretive notes that survive political rotation.
Provider Capture	Transparency by default; regular publication of user charters and dashboards.
Stigma & Discrimination	Inclusion by design; reasonable accommodation SOPs.
Documentation Barriers	Alternative verification safeguards; no exclusion based on ID status.
Digital Harm	Privacy-by-design and independent review of automated decision-making.
