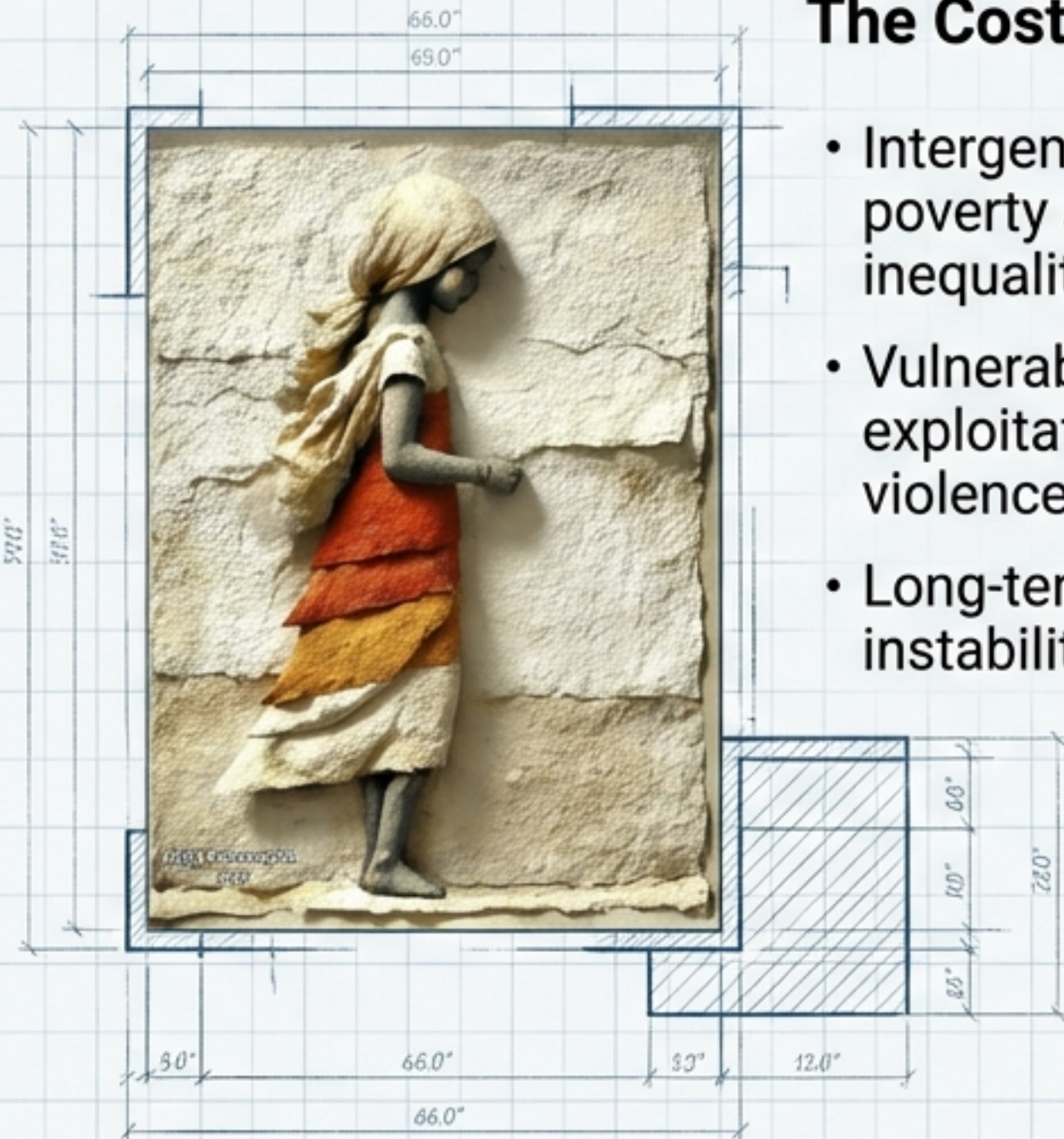

# The Strategic Rationale: Cost of Inaction vs. Dividend of Investment

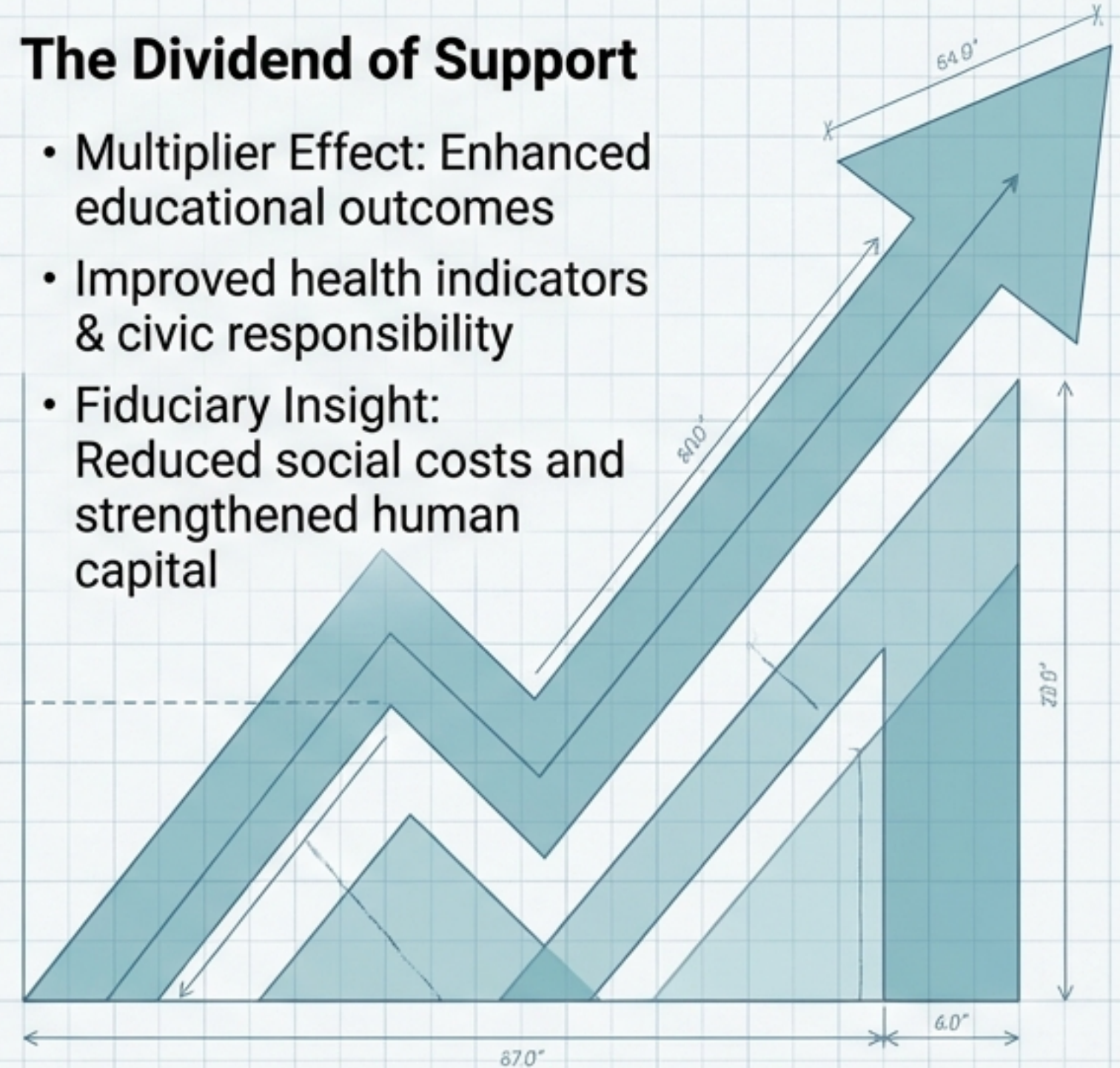


## The Cost of Neglect

- Long-term social instability

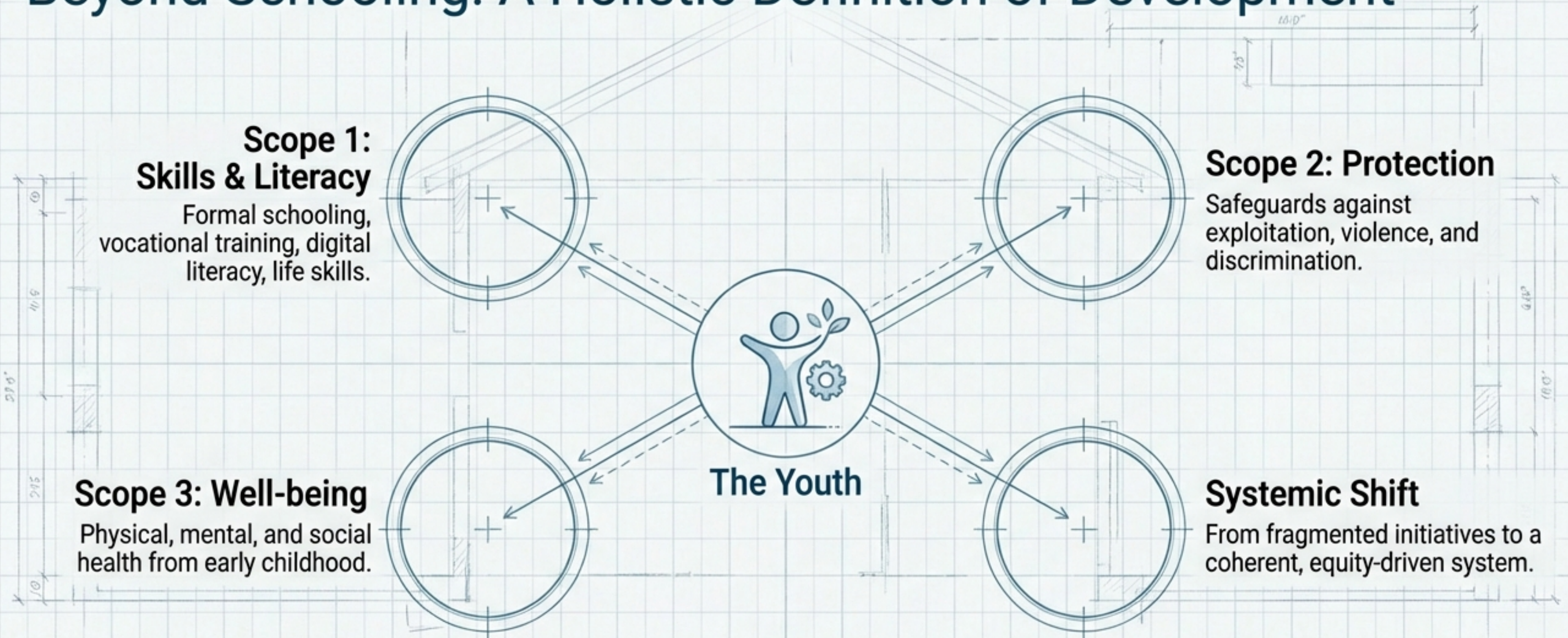
## The Dividend of Support

- Fiduciary Insight: Reduced social costs and strengthened human capital





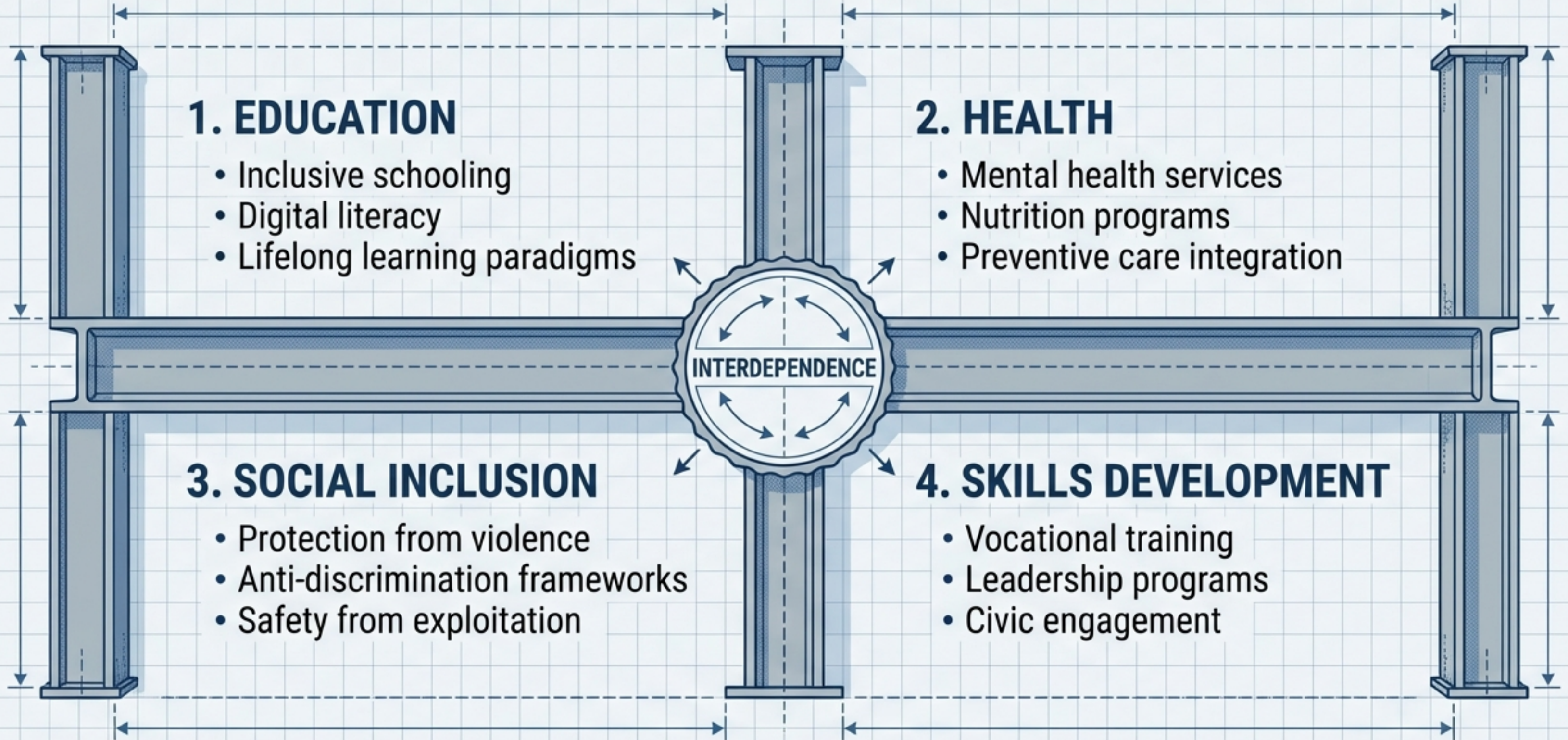
# Beyond Schooling: A Holistic Definition of Development

Campaigns challenging harmful cultural norms and promoting positive parenting.

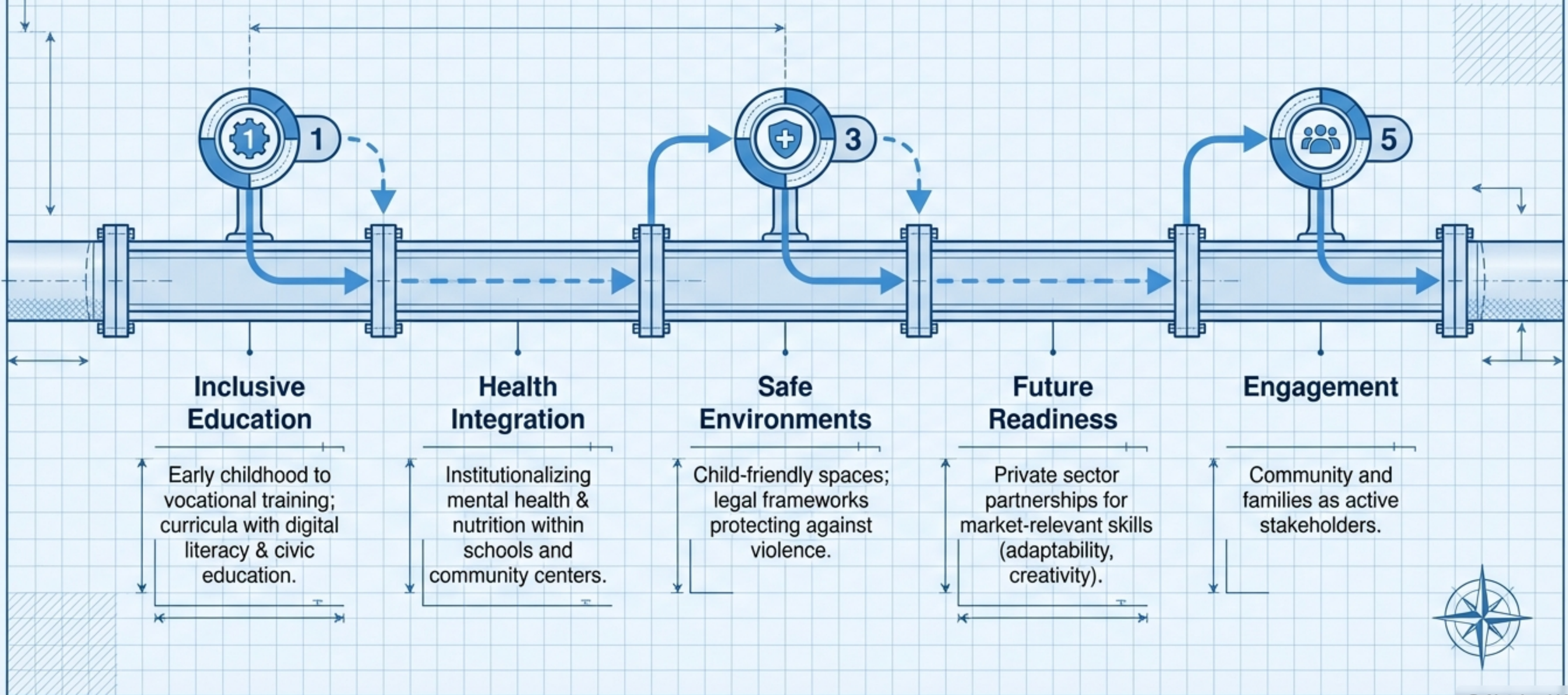


## **LEVERAGE Technology**

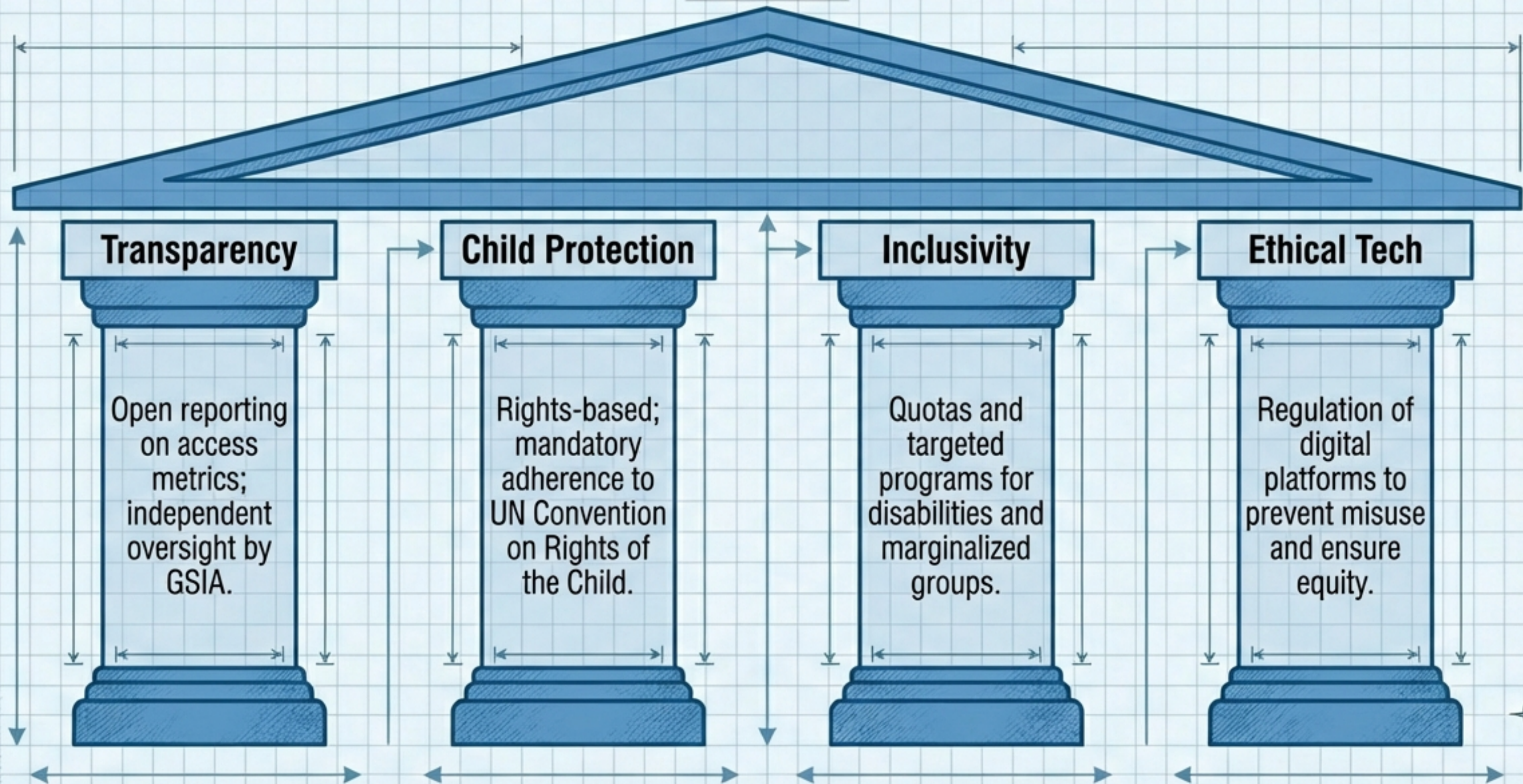

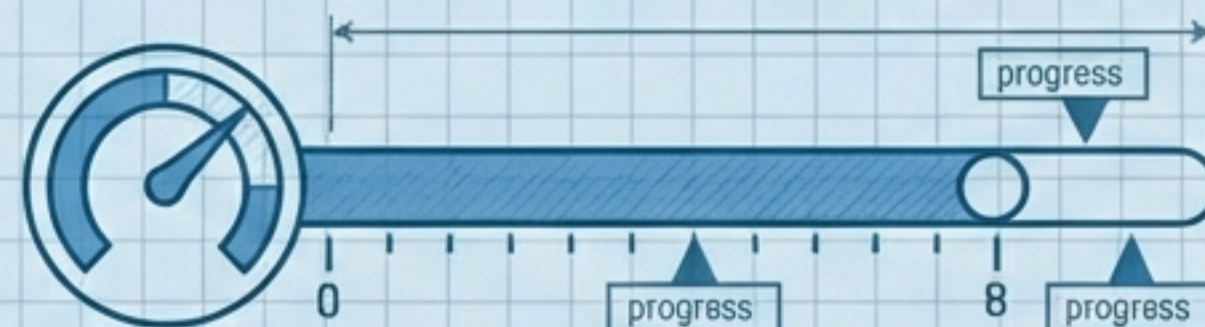

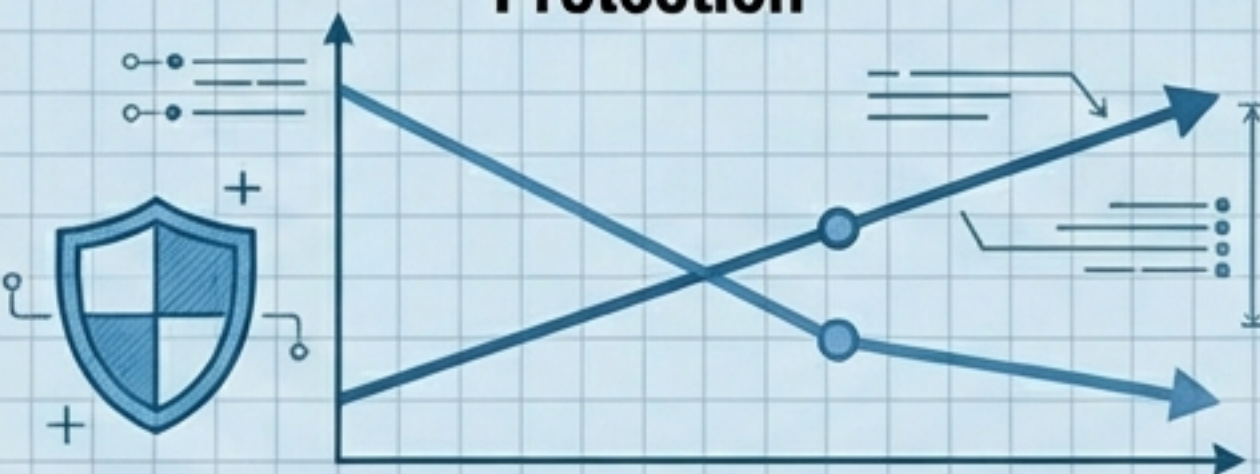
