Key Rule: Money moves by rule, not discretion.





Prevents indefinite occupation and institutional sprawl.






Role: The Public Record and 'Brain' of the operation.



The Financing Architecture


Principles-Based and Market-Neutral Circuit of Value





Risk, Safeguards & Ethics

RISK	STRUCTURAL SAFEGUARD
Financial Misallocation	Ring-fencing & Ballot-based allocation.
Market Distortion	Strict separation of roles (Platform cannot allocate).
Mission Creep	Entry–Monitor–Exit discipline.
Reputational Opacity	Publication is a condition of legitimacy.
