GSDA is the central funding body mobilizing capital for social equity, cooperative governance, and sustainable development. We do not control operations; we shape the financial narrative that enables them.

## The Hybrid Platform



### Key Pillars

- **The Mission:** Activating capital for impact (SDEP, PCPP, PCGG) without taking operational control.
- **The Philosophy:** Social Capitalism—capital as a vehicle for dignity.
- **The Distinction:** Strict focus on financial stewardship and viability, distinct from operational entities.

# An Active Architect of Financial Ecosystems

GSDA functions as a meta-level funding body, structurally positioned above operational layers to ensure bankability and attractiveness to public and private funders.


Strict separation from implementation (funding vs. running) allows GSDA to be a trusted partner to governments and DFIs without political alignment.

# A Pluralistic Funding Ecosystem




**Tiered Pyramid**

# Bridging the Gap: The Financial Translator




Impact: Converts large-scale capital into **locally accessible** instruments, ensuring programs like SDEP are not lost to structural exclusion.

# Instruments for De-Risking and Deployment



## Grants & Subsidies

For early-stage pilots and capacity building; essential for de-risking innovative models.



## Soft Loans

Concessional finance with low interest/deferred repayment for co-ops and SMEs.



## Guarantees

Risk-sharing to backstop loans and encourage private lenders in high-impact communities.



## Blended Finance

Packages combining public, philanthropic, and private capital to layer risk and return.



## Impact-Linked Bonds

Social Capital Notes and bonds tied to measurable social outcomes.



## Regional Funds

Thematic funds for COMESA, EAC, or sectors like digitalisation.

# Portfolio: Food Security & Connectivity




## SDEP (Staple Food Programme)

- **Focus:** Food security, rural development, cooperative farming.
- **GSDA Role:** Capital mobilization for cooperatives, blended finance to complement DFI funding.



## PCPP (Pan-Continental Power Play)

- **Focus:** Youth engagement, infrastructure, cross-border connectivity.
- **GSDA Role:** Funding regional hubs, PPP frameworks, private capital engagement.



# Portfolio: Building Institutions for Equity

## SUDESA (South Sudan)



Digitalisation & Social Equity Agency

Co-owned with Govt of South Sudan. GSDA structures funding for digital infrastructure and the 10-year roadmap, engaging Swedish/Intl investors.

## PCGG (Pan-Continental Global Ground)



Democratic Innovation

Focus on cooperative governance (CUWE, CEIU). GSDA finances the setup of cooperative institutions and pilot implementations globally.

## CODESA (COMESA)




Regional Scaling Model

## Leadership & Oversight


- Board of Financial Trustees: Independent experts, Creativa reps, Partners (DVGulford).

## Opportunities



## Threats


- Market volatility affecting private capital.
