

Foundational Purpose and Institutional Identity

GSEA is constituted as the principal normative authority within the Creativa Center ecosystem, entrusted with the long-term custodianship of the Agenda for Social Equity 2074.

The Mandate

To govern across normative, academic, and cross-sectoral domains without susceptibility to short-term political, market, or organisational pressures.



Custodial Canopy

- ✓ **Permanence:** GSEA remains the fixed north star against which all movement is measured.
- ✓ **Doctrine:** A unified legal and institutional doctrine for social equity.
- ✓ **Coherence:** Ensures academic, cooperative, and citizen-centric governance operates in unison.

Its function is not merely administrative; it is constitutional.

The Board

Ultimate fiduciary and normative authority.
Promulgates standards, ratifies charters.
Staggered terms to prevent capture.

The Secretariat

Led by Secretary-General.
Executive functions only.
Holds no operational programme authority.

Rule-Bound Authority: Decisions are recorded, auditable, and reversible only through formal procedures.

Certification




Formal recognition of conformity based on evidence, not intent.




Binding interpretations to resolve ambiguity.


Advisory support, gap assessments, and onboarding. Note: Advisory ceases where audit begins.

Evidence Hierarchy



Indicator Tiers

- 1. Institutional Integrity:** Governance compliance, ethics adherence.
- 2. Programme Performance:** Pipeline strength, delivery fidelity.
- 3. Equity Outcomes:** Access, inclusion, distributional fairness.

Data Governance: Strict separation between data producers and auditors to prevent conflict of interest.


The Enforcement Mechanism: Compliance Logic

	Conformant	Indicators meet targets. Decision: Renewal of certification.
	Conformant with Observations	Minor weaknesses. Decision: Conditional renewal, targeted remediation.
	At-Risk	Negative trends. Decision: Enhanced monitoring, corrective action plans.
	Non-Conformant	Material failures. Decision: Suspension, revocation, public notice.

Key Takeaway: Equity is measurable and enforceable.


