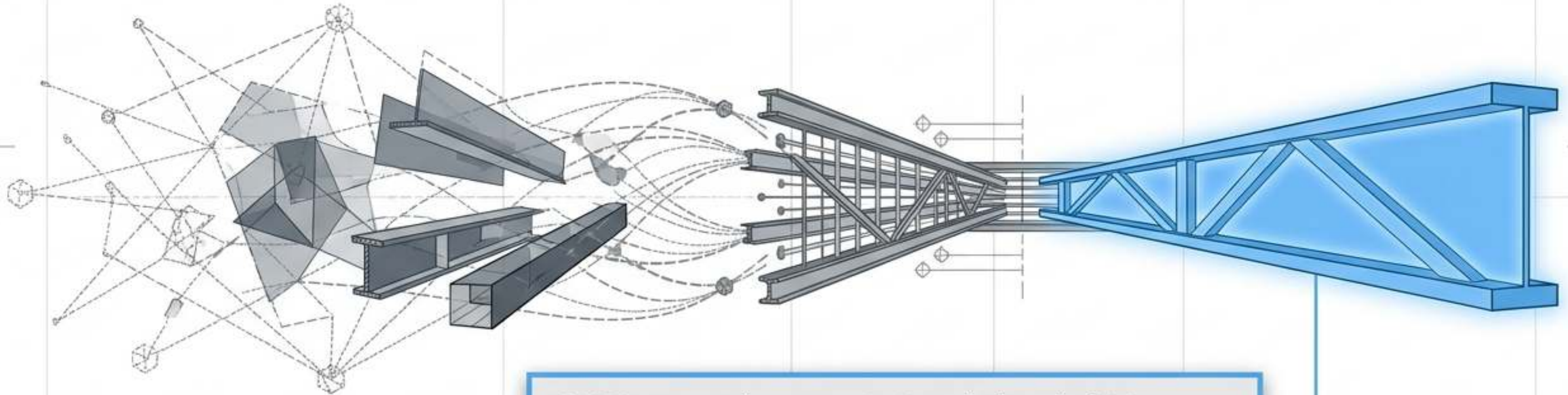
# FROM ECOSYSTEM FORMATION TO INSTITUTIONAL MAINTENANCE

The formal establishment of UASE.

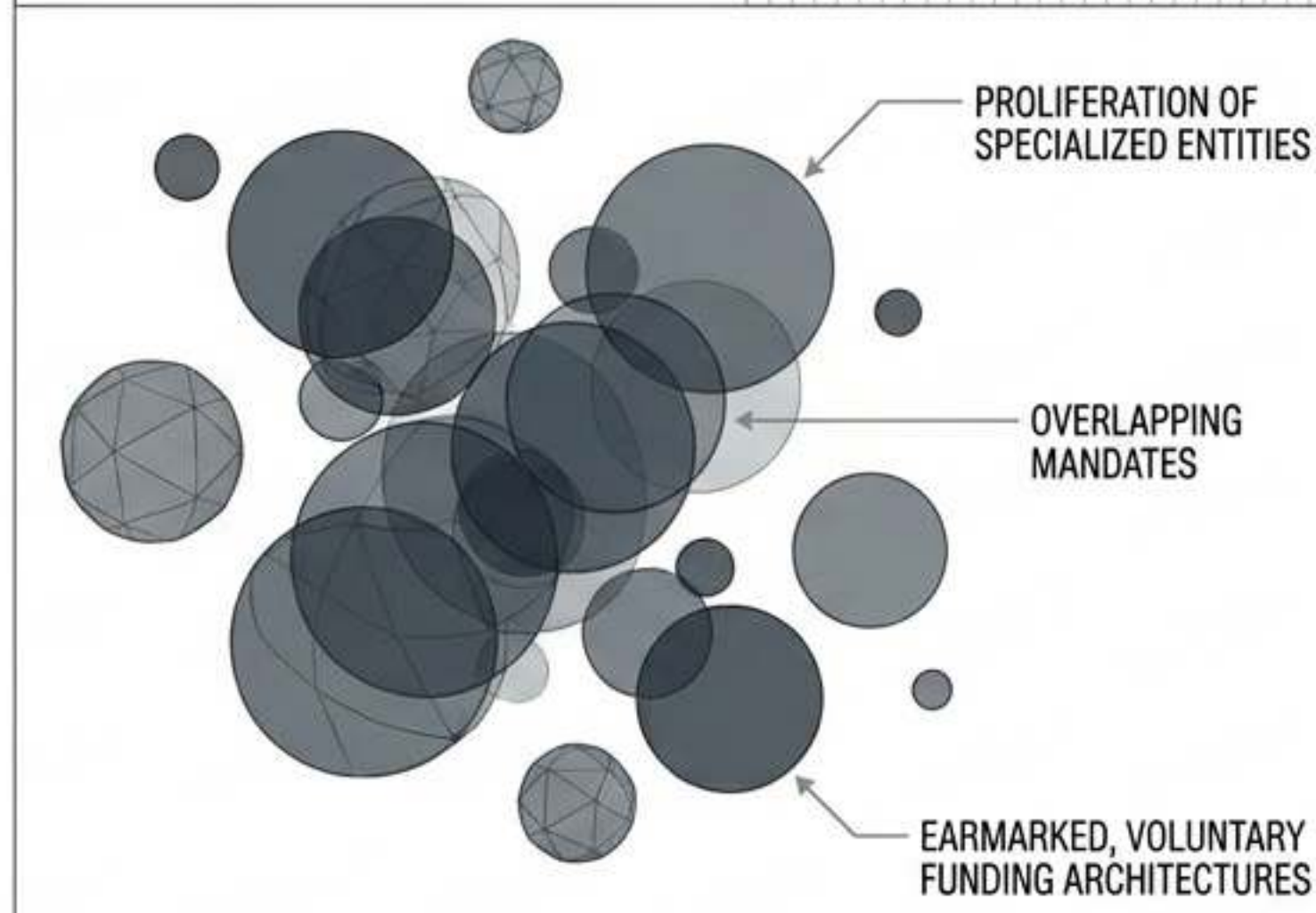

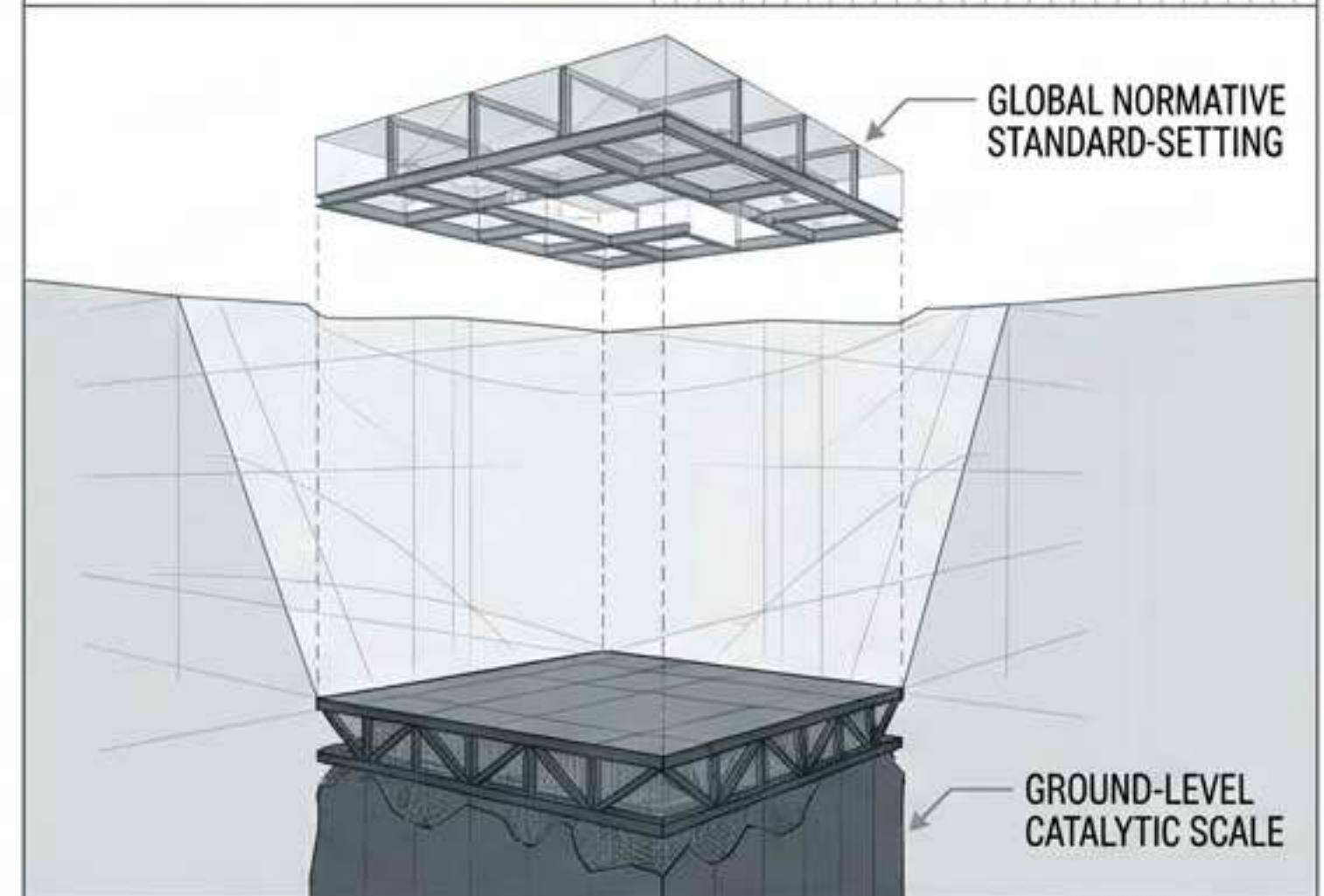

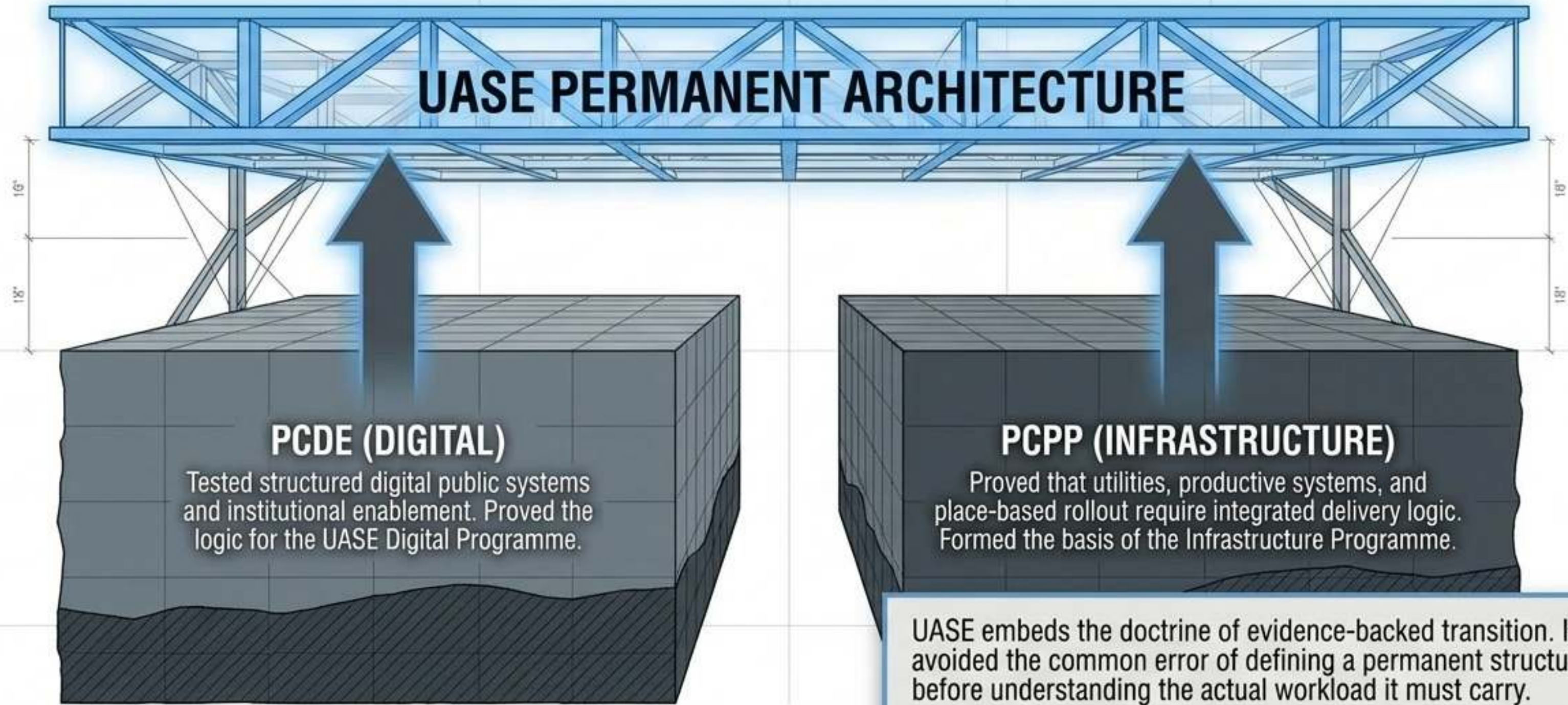


### THE IMPLEMENTATION GAP

UASE does not critique or seek to replace this system; it is built specifically to occupy the narrower, deeper space of operational delivery.

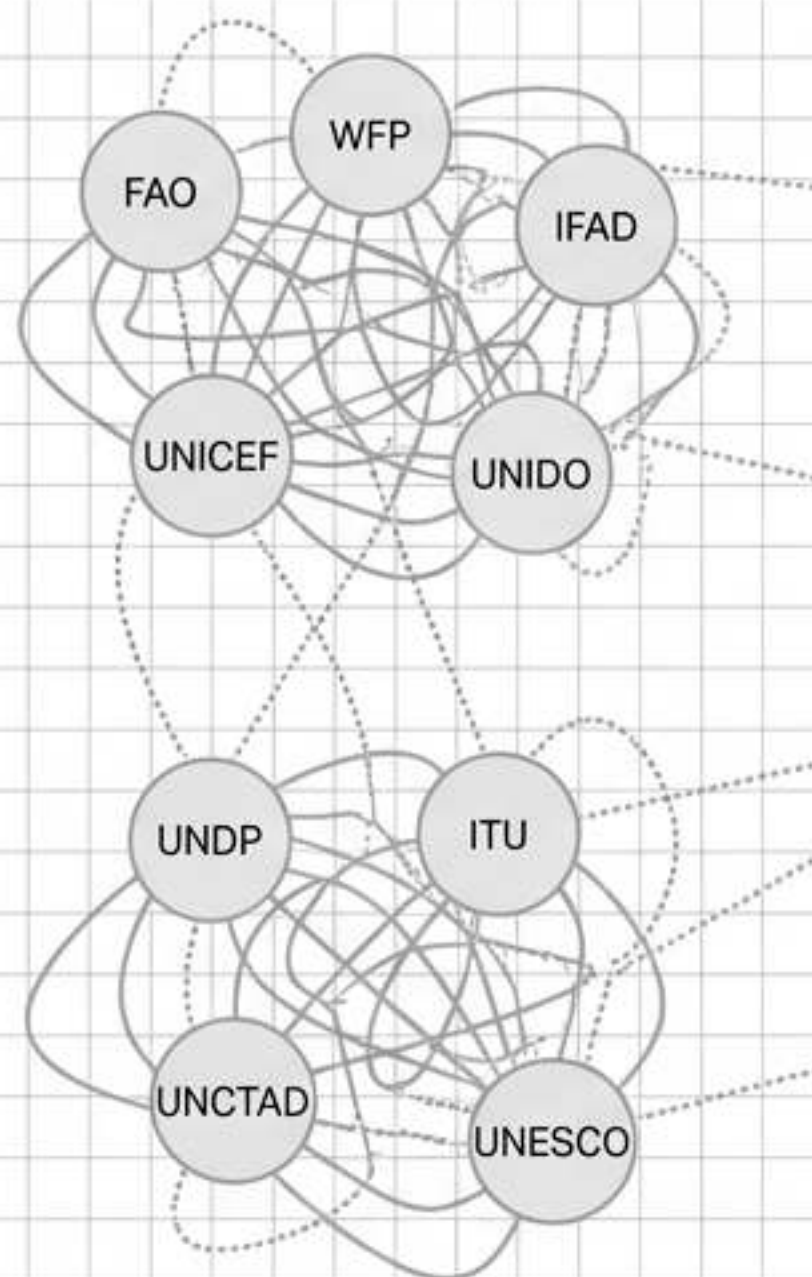

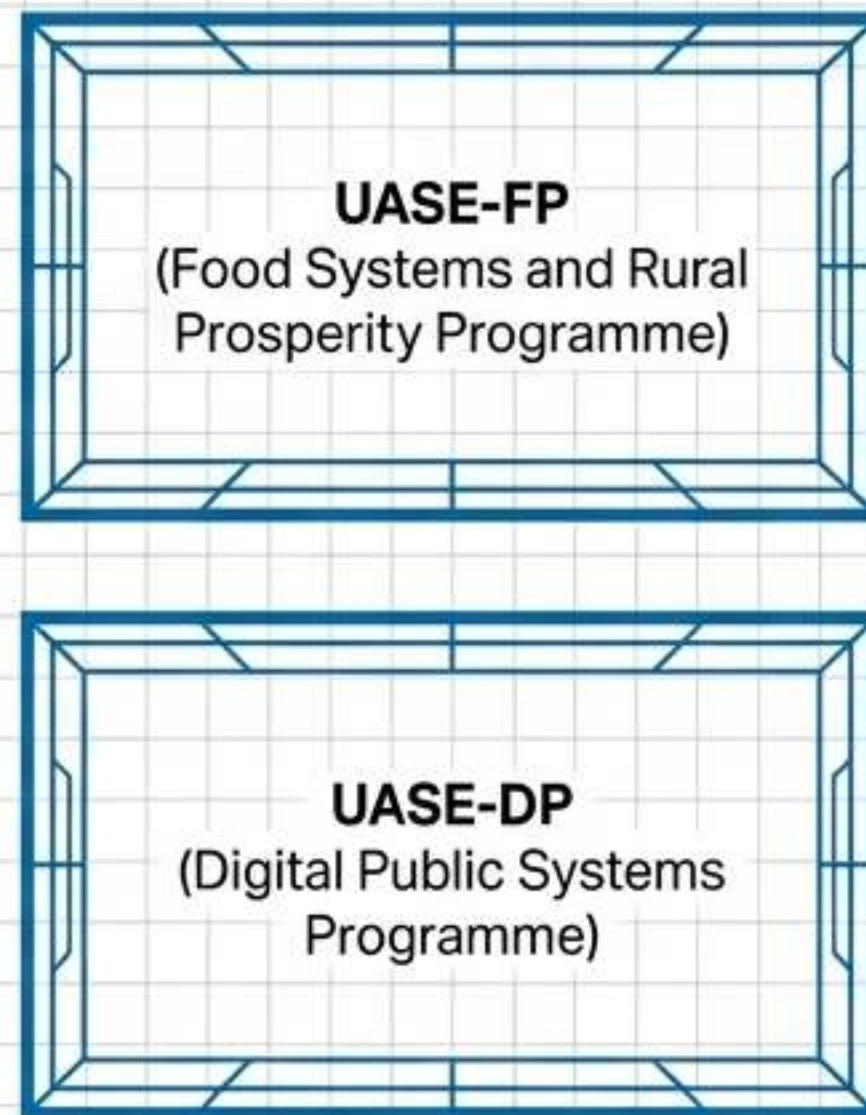
UASE embeds the doctrine of evidence-backed transition. It avoided the common error of defining a permanent structure before understanding the actual workload it must carry.

## Legacy Multilateral Clusters

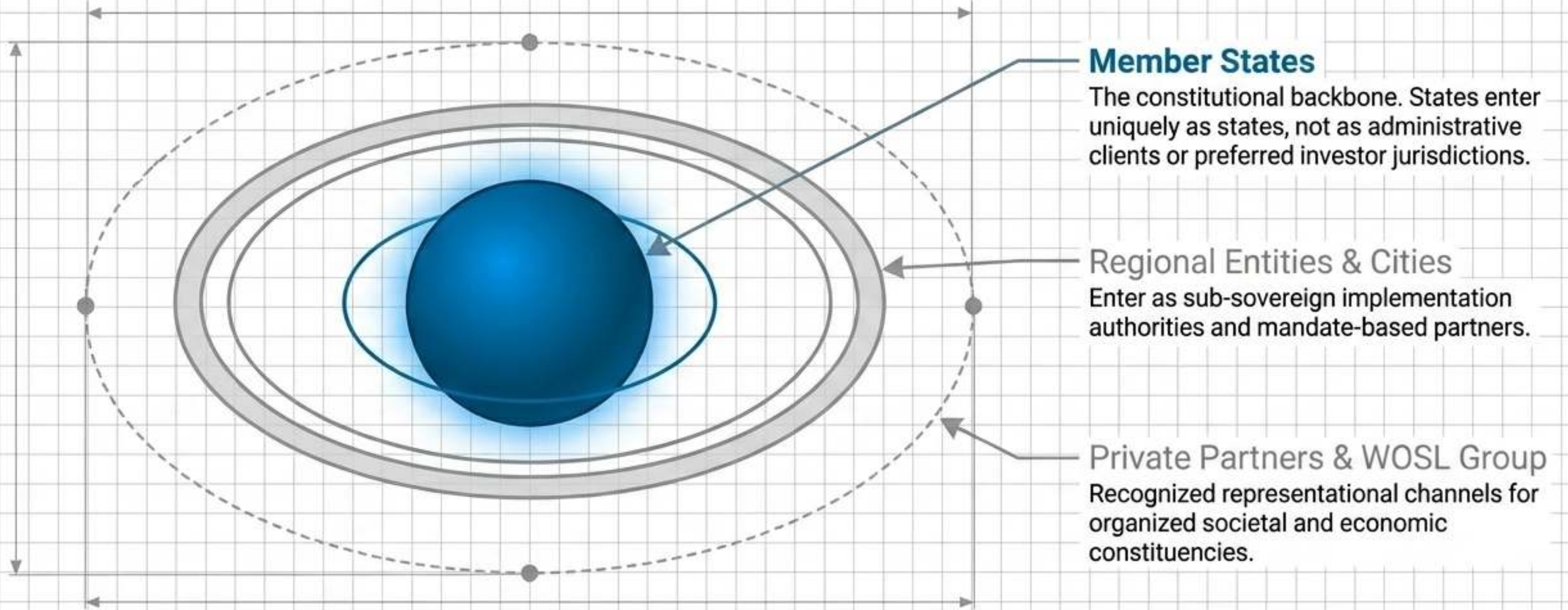


## UASE Functional Compression



**Takeaway:** UASE compresses overlapping inter-agency environments into governed program windows, shifting from thematic advisory to functional execution.

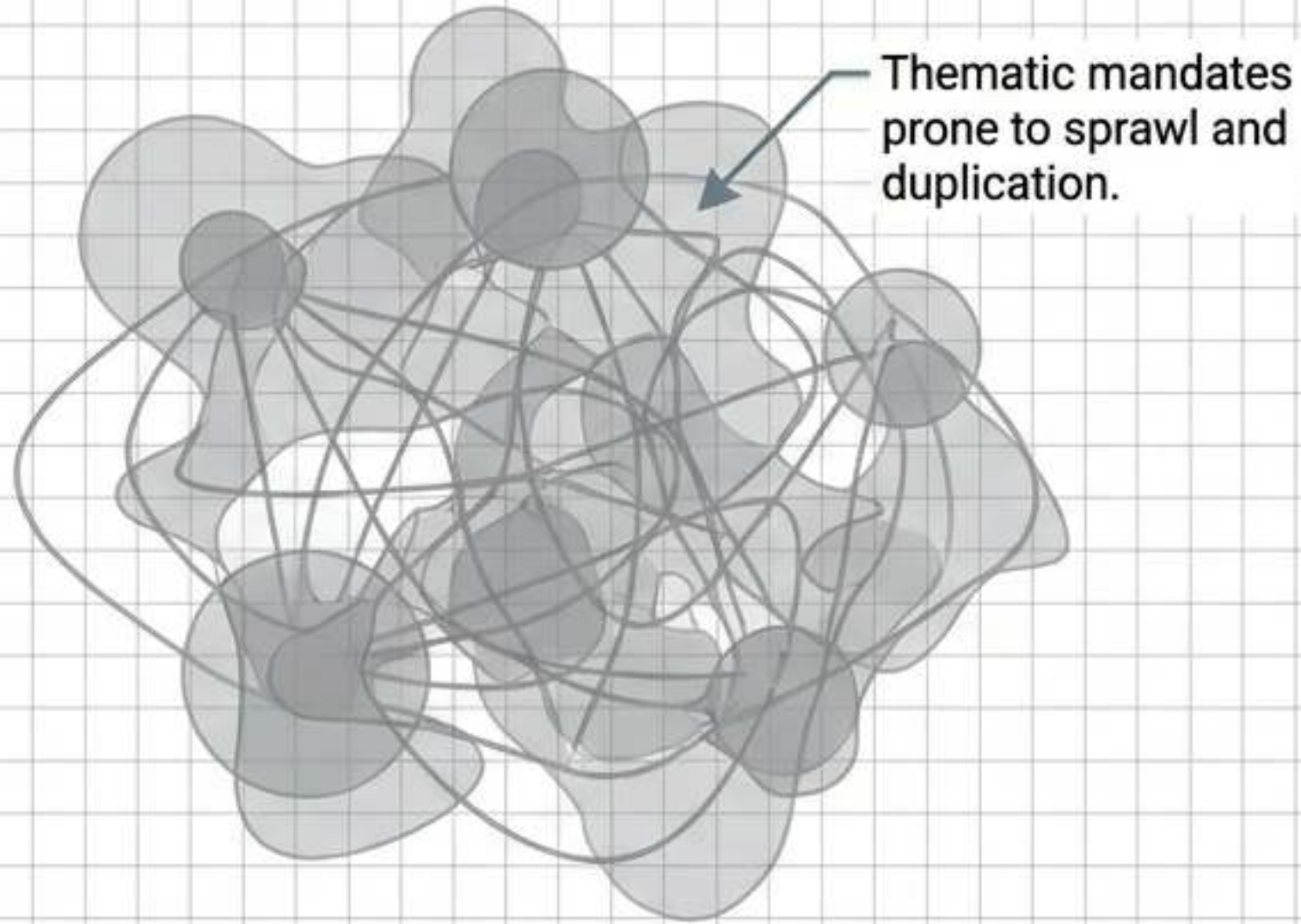
# A Constitutional Logic Distinguishing Sovereigns from Sub-Sovereign Actors



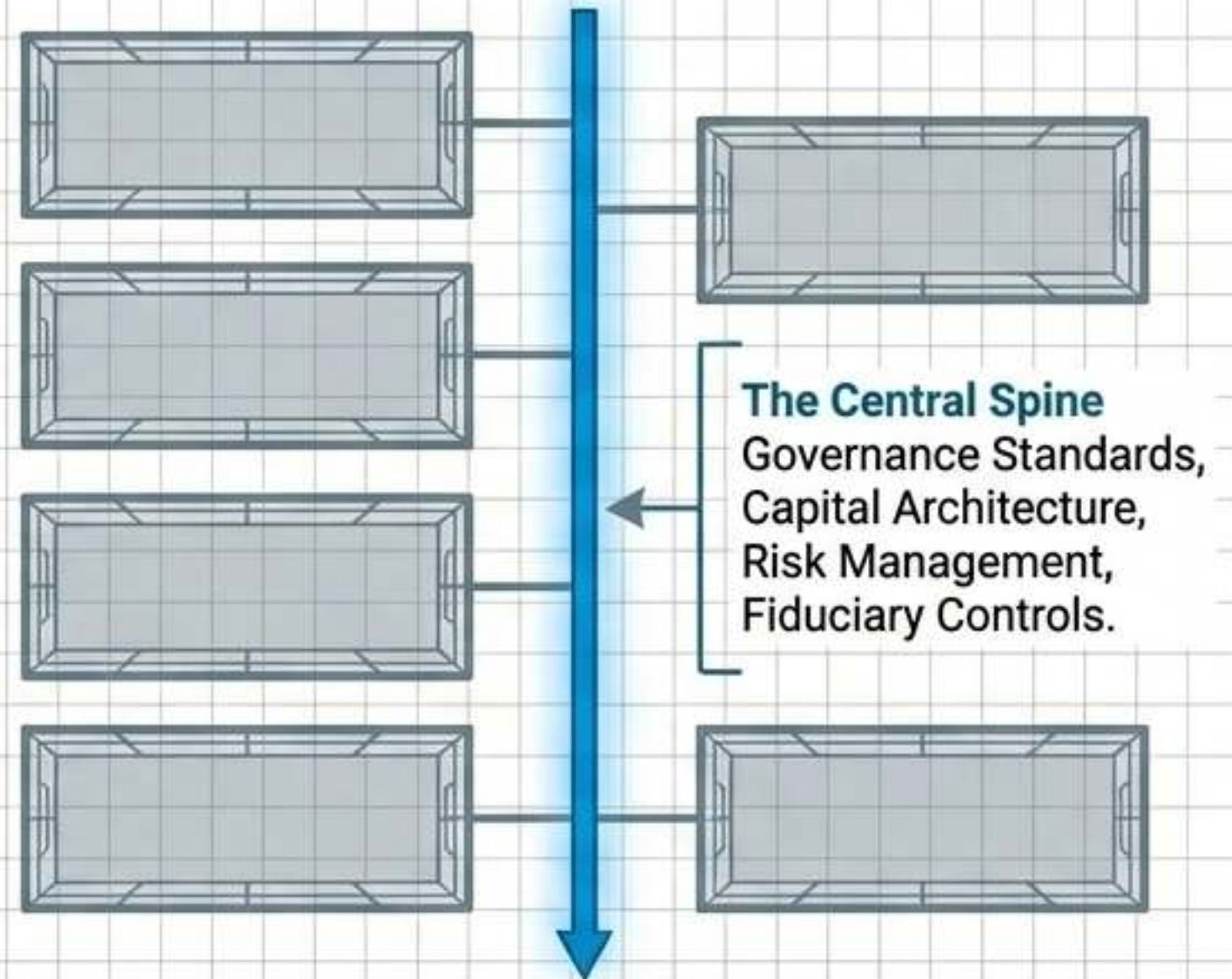
To reflect a serious multilateral logic, participation must carry a defined bundle of rights. A regional compact cannot silently nullify member-state participation.

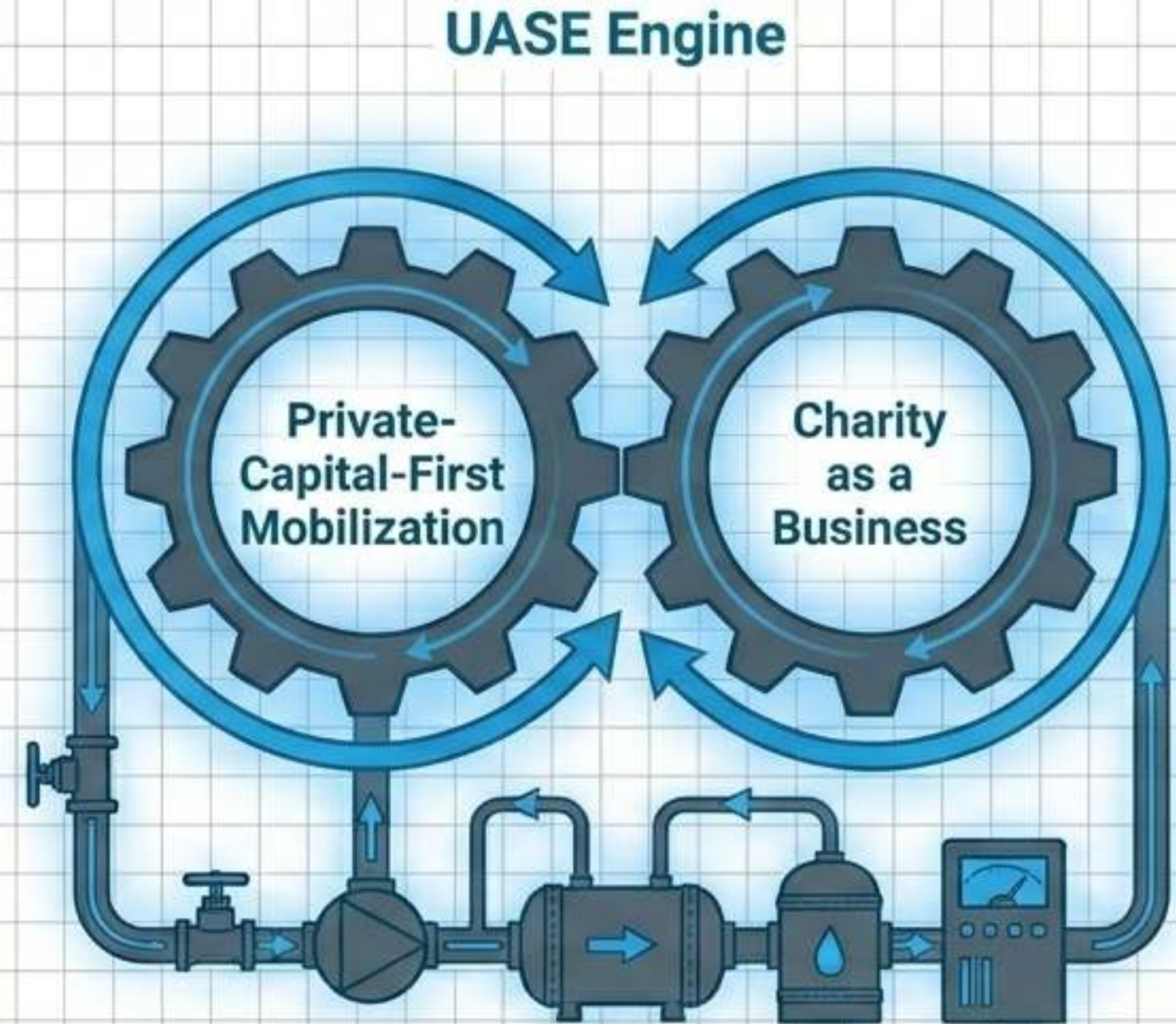
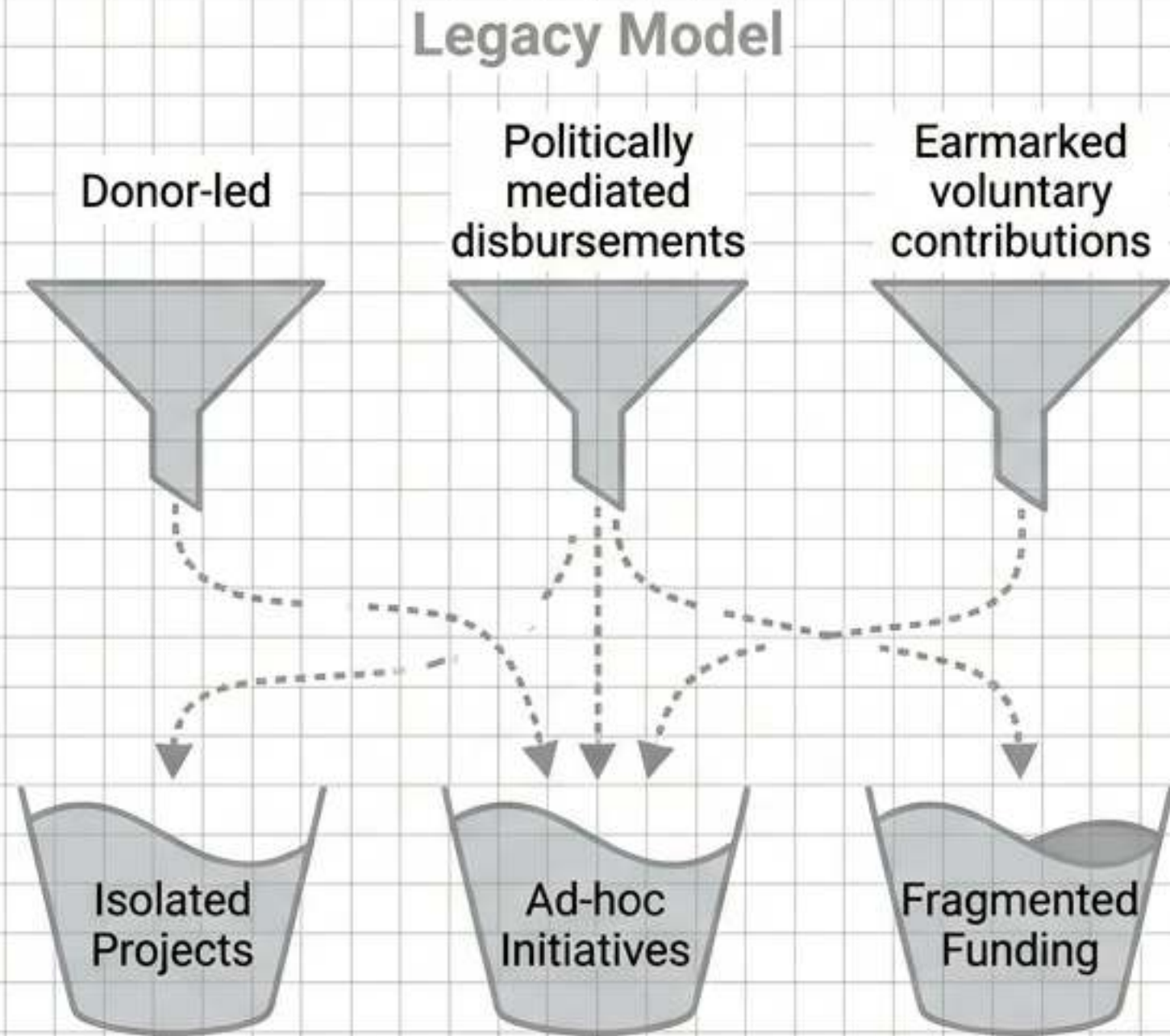


The UASE Way



**Core Principle:** The spine does not exist to erase program identity. It exists to ensure that program identity remains subordinate to alliance identity. Mandate duplication and ad hoc proliferation are expressly prohibited.

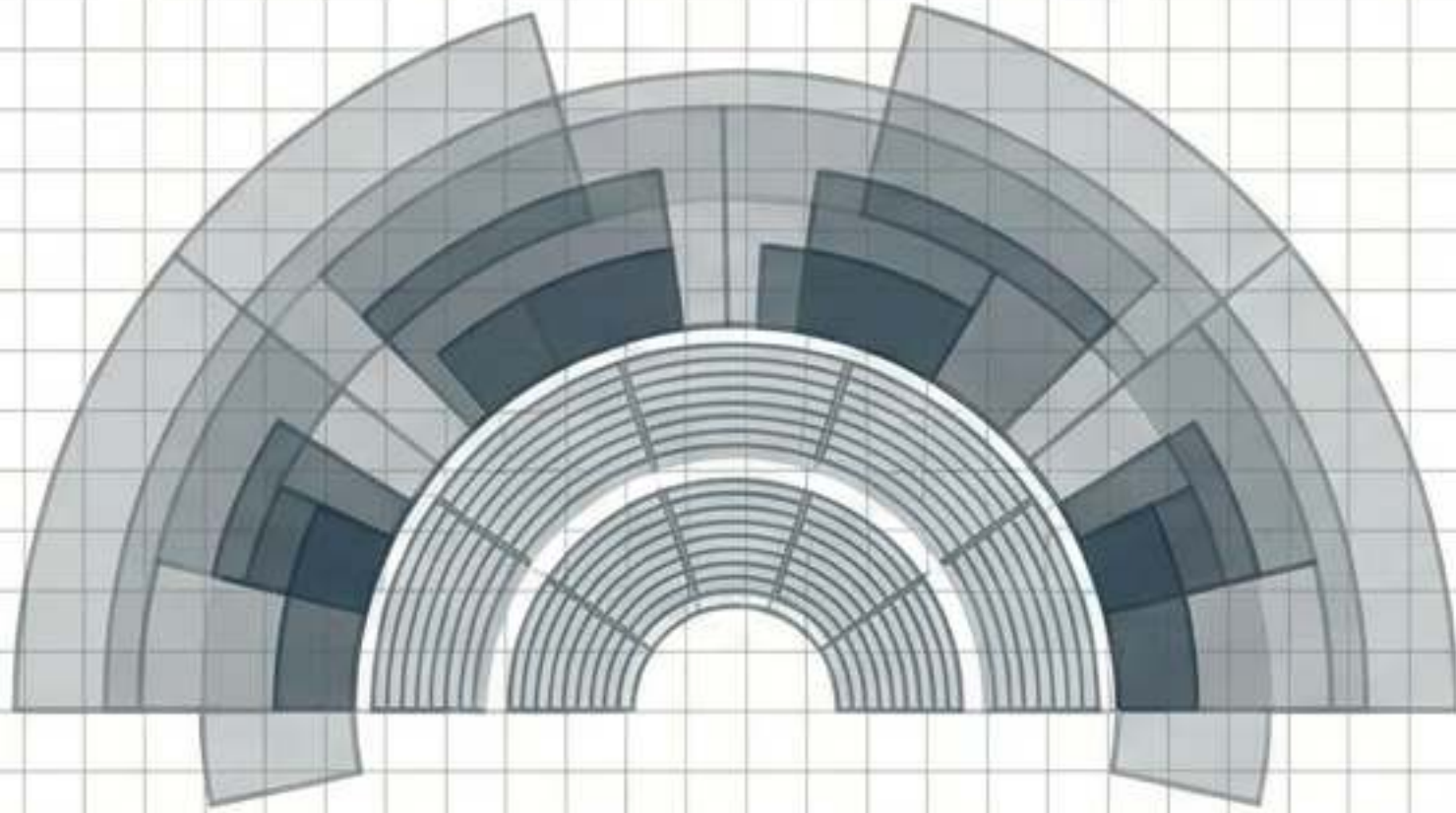
# From Earmarked Dependency to Integrated Capital Engineering



The current multilateral system separates capital formation from operational delivery. UASE resolves this by building an alliance where catalytic preparation, capital mobilization, and local market participation are treated as one integrated discipline.

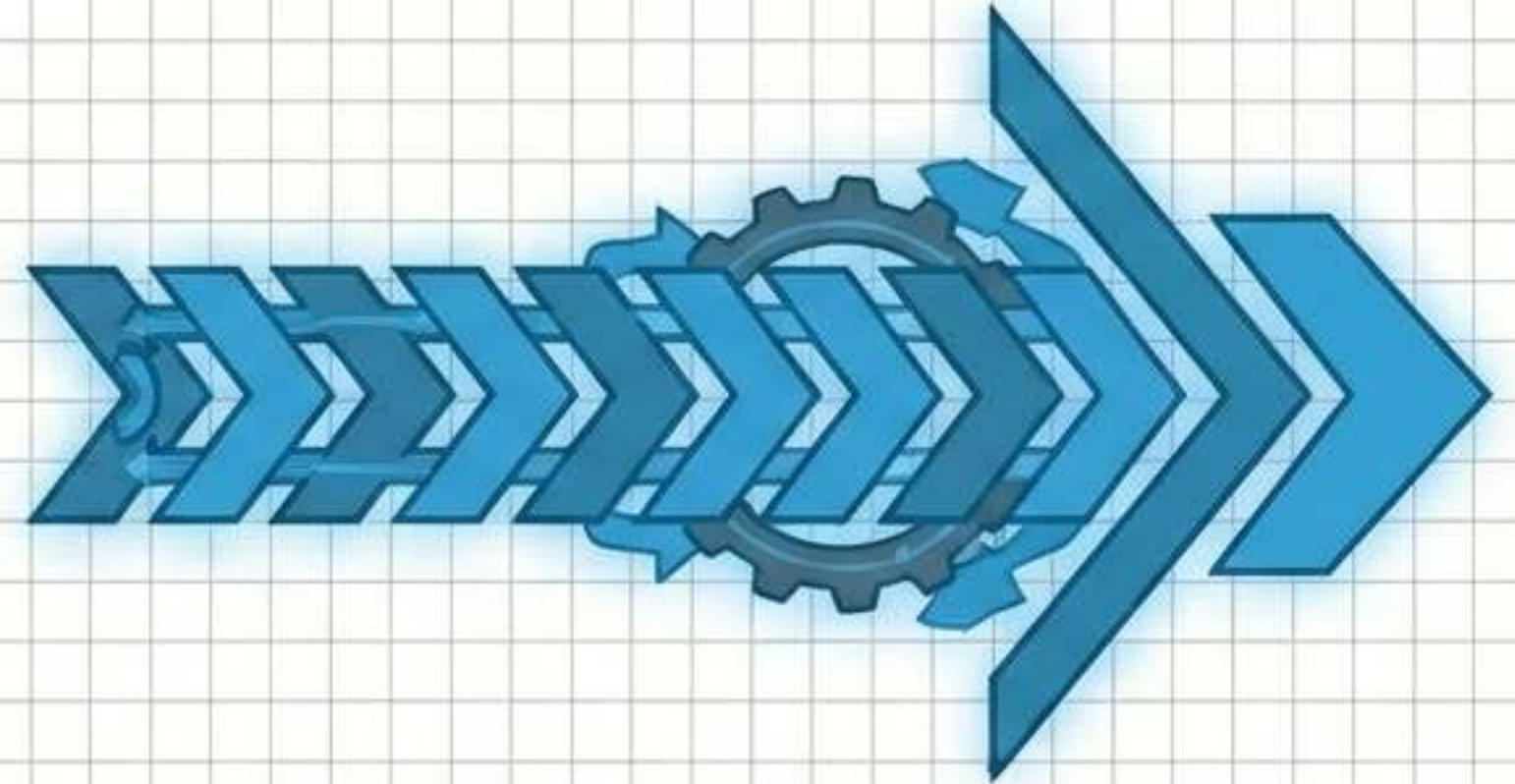
# An Instrument of Delivery, Not a Forum for Deliberation

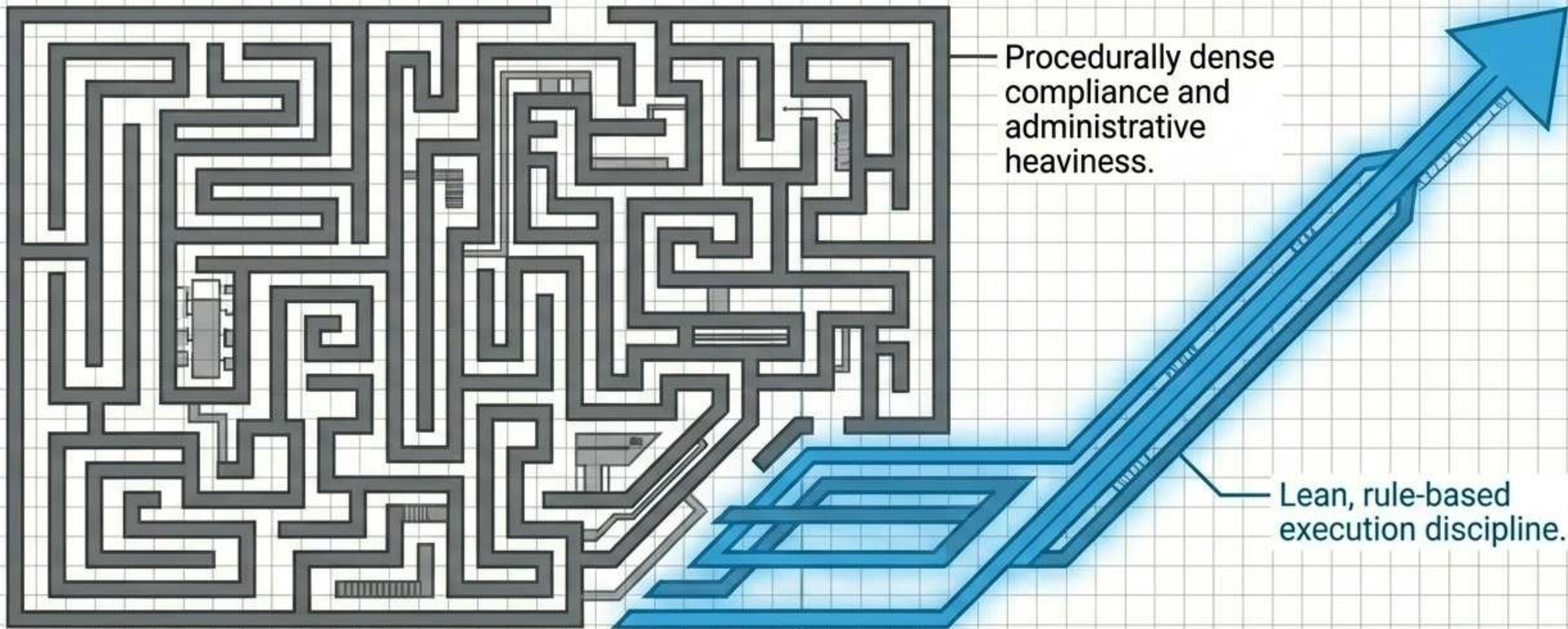

**Binding Charter Excerpt:** The powers of UASE are explicitly limited to implementation. UASE shall not assume political authority, regulatory powers, or coercive enforcement capabilities. It shall not act as an alternative forum for intergovernmental negotiation.

# Replacing Procedural Density with Execution Discipline



UASE utilizes mandate compression and strict central governance as constitutional safeguards against institutional entropy. It shortens the chain from strategic conception to capital structuring to ground-level delivery, keeping the organization slim, premium, and operationally serious.

# The Operational Matrix: Multilateral Legacy vs. **UASE** Architecture
